GOVERNOR'S CITATION 2019-2020

The Governor's Citation recognizes Rotary clubs that support Rotary vision by achieving certain goals. Our clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, clubs need to begin the year as active clubs that are in good standing and remain so throughout the year.

Achievements will be compared with membership figures from 1 July 2019 to 1 March 2020 and will be recognized in the District conference in Amman in May 2020.

DISTRICT PROGRAMS

Achieve at least 3 of the following goals:

- Sponsor or co-sponsor an Interact or Rotaract club
- Implement 1 project within the program theme 2019-2020 "New Generation... Clean Energy."
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a new Rotary club or a new Rotary Community Corps
- Sponsor a RYLA participant
- At least 3 Rotarians join Rotary Action Groups or Rotary Fellowships

THE ROTARY FOUNDATION PROGRAMS

Achieve at least 6 of the following goals:

- Appoint an active club Rotary Foundation committee comprised of no less than 3 members and report the chair to Rotary International.
- Contribute at least \$100 per capita to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund
- Contribute \$1000 to the Endowment Fund
- Apply for one new Global Grant project serving the theme of the year: "New Generation.. Clean Energy"
- Contribute with \$750 for PolioPlus program directly or by holding an event to raise funds for it.
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a global grant for any of *Gift of Life International* programs in the District.
- Have a 100% Paul Harris club
- Have a 100% Sustaining Member Club
- Have a one major donor at least
- Pay the due TRF donations not later than 31 Dec 2019

GOVERNOR'S CITATION 2019-2020

CLUB ADMINISTRATION / ONLINE TOOLS

Achieve at least 4 of the following goals:

- Have the 100% of club members registered in My Rotary
- Achieve at least 20 goals at Rotary Club Central
- Have an average meeting attendance not less than 60%
- Report attendance regularly to District website
- Pay District & RI on time
- Perform 6 activities at least in respect to the Rotary calendar.
- Have 6 meetings at least involving family members and friends

PUBLIC IMAGE

Achieve at least 4 of the following goals:

- Use Rotary's brand guidelines, templates, People of Action campaign materials, and related resources.
- Submit at least one article per month in local or social media showing the "Rotarians in Action" (project and activities)
- Make your club newsletter weekly (electronic or printed)
- Arrange for the club's members to talk with the media to tell your club's and Rotary's story
- Have not less than 30% of members registered in the 7th Annual District Conference (Amman, May 2020).
- Have at least one member attending the Rotary International Convention (Honolulu, June 2020)

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Achieve at least 4 of the following goals:

- Increase the number of members involved in service projects
- Hold an event to raise funds for, or to increase awareness of Rotary's work
- Conduct a significant local or international service project in one of Rotary's six areas of focus
- Post successful club projects, with details about activities, volunteer hours, and funds raised, on Rotary.org
- Continue or establish a partnership with a corporate, governmental, or nongovernmental entity and work on a project together
- Make your project stronger by involving Rotaract and Interact club members, Rotary partners or Rotarian Action Groups, Rotary Community Corps, Intercountry Committees.

GOVERNOR'S CITATION 2019-2020

MEMBERSHIP

Achieve at least 5 of the following goals:

- Appoint an active club membership committee comprised of no less than 3 members and report the chair to Rotary International
- Achieve a net gain in membership in respect to club's original number of members:
 - Clubs that are equal or less than 10 members: to achieve a total membership count of 12 members
 - Clubs that are more than 10 members and equal or less than 20 members: to achieve a total membership count of 22
 - Clubs that are more than 20 members: to achieve 20% increase in membership
- Maintain or improve your club's retention of current and new members: of 100% of the year 2018-2019 by 1 July 2019.
- Achieve a net gain of 1 member in female members or members under the age of 40
- Host an event for Rotary alumni, and highlight Rotary's networking opportunities
- Recruit at least one new member from Rotary Alumni
- Conduct a study of your members' occupations, and work to align your membership with the mix of businesses and professions in your community

Total Goals: 42

Minimum to be Completed: 26

DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S CITATION WITH DISTINCTION 2019-2020

In addition to earning the Rotary Citation, you need to achieve at least 5 goals to receive Citation with Distinction:

- Achieve a net gain of five or more members
- Sponsor a new rotary club
- Organize a family-oriented service project that connects 60% of families of your members, youth program participants, and others
- Hosting a mega fundraising event to sponsor one mega intercountry project
- Initiate or continue a leadership, personal, or professional development program to enhance members' skills
- Show how your club's members are People of Action by promoting your club and its service activities on social media at least four times per month; vibrant club
- Host an event for Rotary awareness for non-Rotarians
